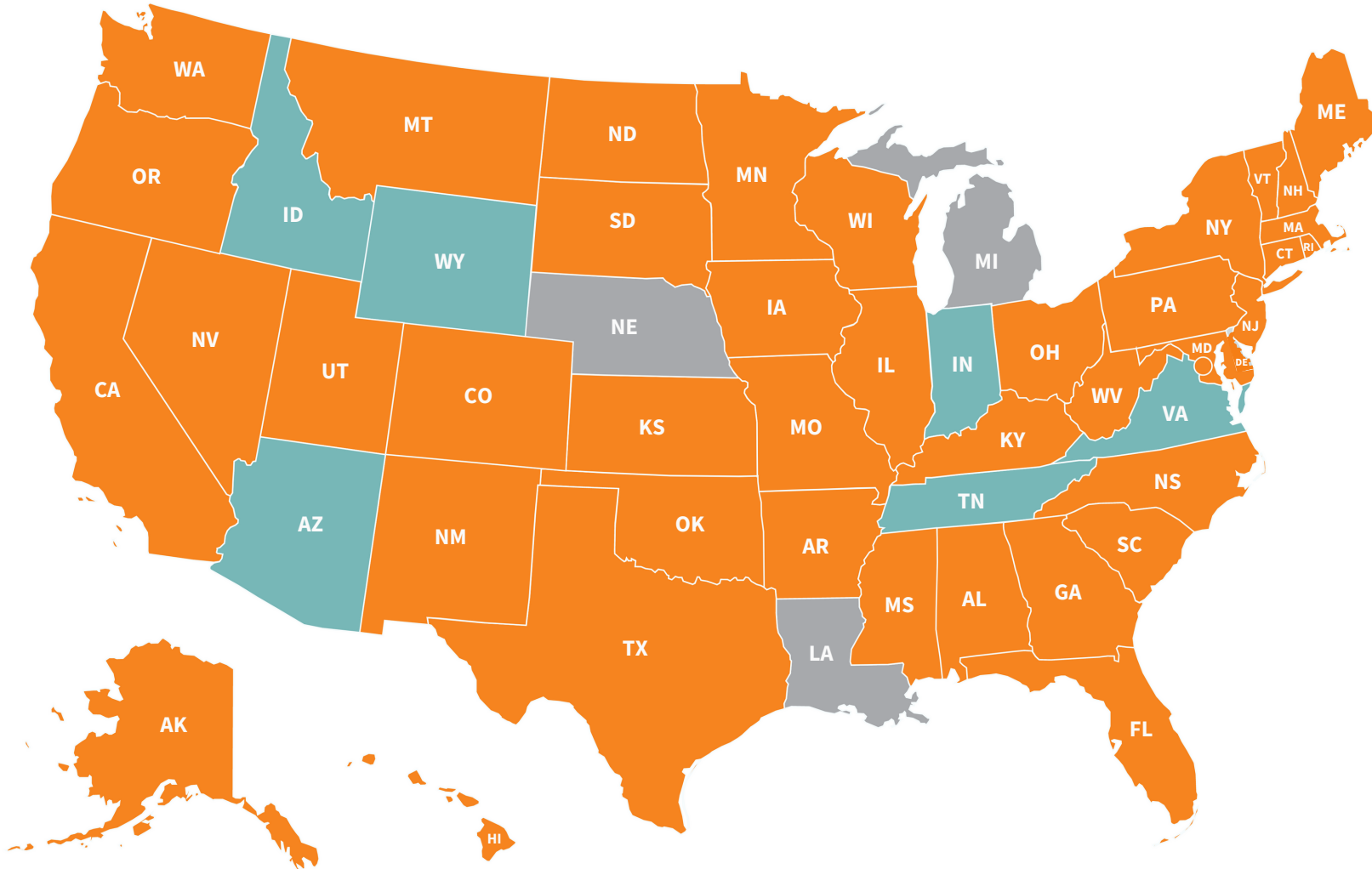


U.S. Surrogacy Law By State



● SURROGACY FRIENDLY

These states either expressly permit surrogacy by statute or case law, or have no law prohibiting surrogacy. A legal process exists in these states to establish parental rights.

● CAUTION

These states present potential legal obstacles and require additional legal processes depending on the circumstance. In limited circumstances, surrogacy is practiced in these states, but results may be unpredictable.

AZ, ID, IN, TN, VA, WY

● RESTRICTED/ PROHIBITED

These states prohibit or criminalize surrogacy, or refuse to enforce surrogacy contracts. Surrogacy is not widely practiced and is not advised in these states.
